



Announcing the Annual ICE FORUM[®] Ice Award, presented by the IceForum and the Georgia Figure Skating Club.

PURPOSE: In recognition of the hard work and dedication of our competition skaters, the Ice Forum and the Georgia Figure Skating Club (GaFSC) are sponsoring an Annual Ice Award, open to members of the Georgia Figure Skating Club. The purpose of the award is to provide support for skaters who are actively representing the GaFSC in competition.

AWARD: A single one-month pass for unlimited freestyle sessions, to be applied in the month the skater chooses in the year the award is earned. There will be one monthly pass awarded each year for each rink: Duluth and Town Center. The winners for the year will be announced at the annual GaFSC banquet.

JUDGING: An independent judging panel will be appointed by the GaFSC board. Panelists will include figure skating supporters or professionals who are not currently serving on the board, coaching at the rink where the applicants skate, and are not related to any skater applying for the award. Applicants will be judged on the basis of information provided in the completed application, which provides information about their skating goals, and their competitive skating and their support of the GaFSC.

QUALIFICATIONS to be considered for the award:

- 1. The skater is a member of the GaFSC and has a full skating membership. All full skating members of the GaFSC are eligible to participate.
- 2. Completion of 10 volunteer service hours by the skater or the skater's family in support of the GaFSC. Volunteer service hours can be earned by working at a GaFSC event. Examples include (but not limited to): working at the Peach Open/Peach Classic, donating refreshments for a test session or party (\$5 value = 1 hour), coordinating a club activity, playing music for exhibitions, making a donation to the club: \$5=1 hour.
- 3. The skater/parent must submit a completed application form to the club, postmarked by January25.
- 4. Skaters will not be eligible to win the award two years in a row. The winner of the previous award is not eligible to apply in the following year.
